MOST COMMENDABLE PAPER IN EITHER THE AUSTRALIAN VETERINARY JOURNAL, NEW ZEALAND VETERINARY JOURNAL OR AUSTRALIAN VETERINARY PRACTITIONER

Selection criteria

- a. The impact of the paper on the way veterinary science is practiced or influenced will be considered (50%), with papers detailing new treatments, interventions or diagnostic techniques being strongly considered.
- b. Scientific rigor of the paper (30%).
- c. Quality of initial submission (20%).

Selection Process

- 1. The Editor of each Journal submits a shortlist of articles and/or papers published in the preceding 12 months (open source or attached as a document), considering the above criteria in preparing the nominations.
- 2. Nominations to be sent to the Australian and New Zealand College of Veterinary Scientists, online (email/form) or by post to Building 3/2404 Logan Road, Eight Mile Plains, Queensland 4113.
- 3. Nominations close **end of February each year**, and no nominations will be accepted after this date, unless otherwise advised.

Selection Panel

Editor of the relevant journal, Awards Convenor of the Australian and New Zealand College of Veterinary Scientists and a member of Council (for Australian journals) and the NZ representative on Council (for New Zealand journal).

Judgements are final and no further correspondence will be entered into.
