Small Ruminant Chapter ANZCVS

With Local Land Services purchasing nearly \$2000 of FAMACHA cards, that trading was the Chapter's main income source, along with subscriptions of \$420 (down by \$40 on last year).

Supplying that demand from LLS meant we had to purchase more FAMACHA cards this year (within 18 months of the previous purchase); despite that the Chapter's financial position continues to grow healthily, and we have 103 cards on hand to meet anticipated demand over the next 2-3 years. Acknowledgment to Sandra for the FAMACHA card sales initiative and continuing to diligently manage it.

Other expenses were for postage of said cards, and a further payment to the College for the development of the Sheep membership exam held in June/July 2025. We will be due to run another exam in 2027, so can anticipate further expense for that; but our finances can easily support that.
